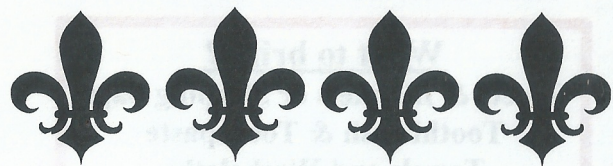
Brandon Wombles

His desire is to see young people find God's will for their lives and help them come to their full potential. He feels that God is raising a group of youth in America to reach this last generation before the second coming of Christ.

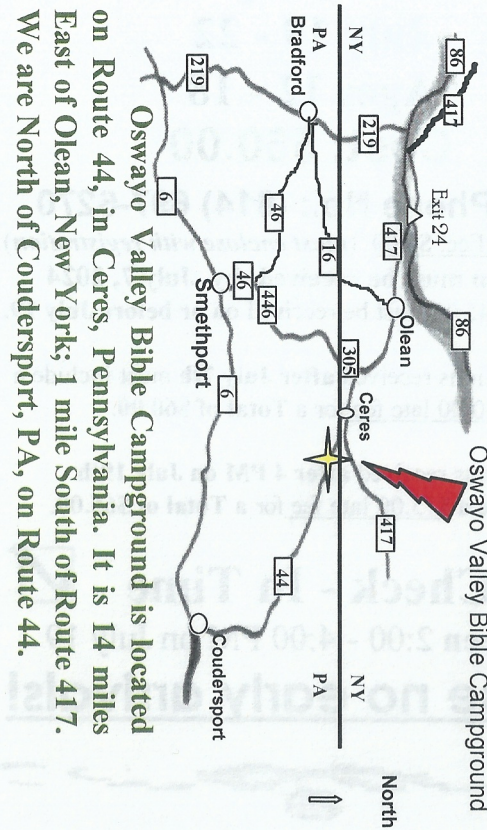

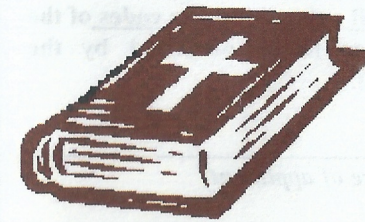
